NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a Public Hearing will be held on **Monday, July 2, 2018, at 7:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers of the City Hall Building, located at 616 NE Fourth Avenue, Camas, Washington, before the Camas City Council.

The purpose of this public hearing is to review and consider an Ordinance granting MCImetro Access Transmission Services Corp., D/B/A Verizon Access Transmission Services, a Non-exclusive Franchise for ten years, to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair a fiber optic telecommunications system, in, along, under, through and below public rights-of-way of the City of Camas, Washington.
