



**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR
SHORELINE SUBSTANTIAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT
FOR MAINTENANCE DREDGING
(File #SHOR17-03)**

Georgia Pacific (GP) Consumer Products (Camas) LLC filed an application for a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit for maintenance dredging on September 18, 2017. The proposed dredging activity will occur in the Camas Slough, of the Columbia River, and disposed at a pre-existing disposal site on Lady Island. The GP Camas Mill is located near the intersection of NE Adams and NE 3rd Avenue and covers 661 acres. The approximate latitude and longitude of the dredging project are as follows: 45.5808 N / -122.4039W; 45.5798 N / -122.41357 W; and 45.5764 N / -122.44537 W.

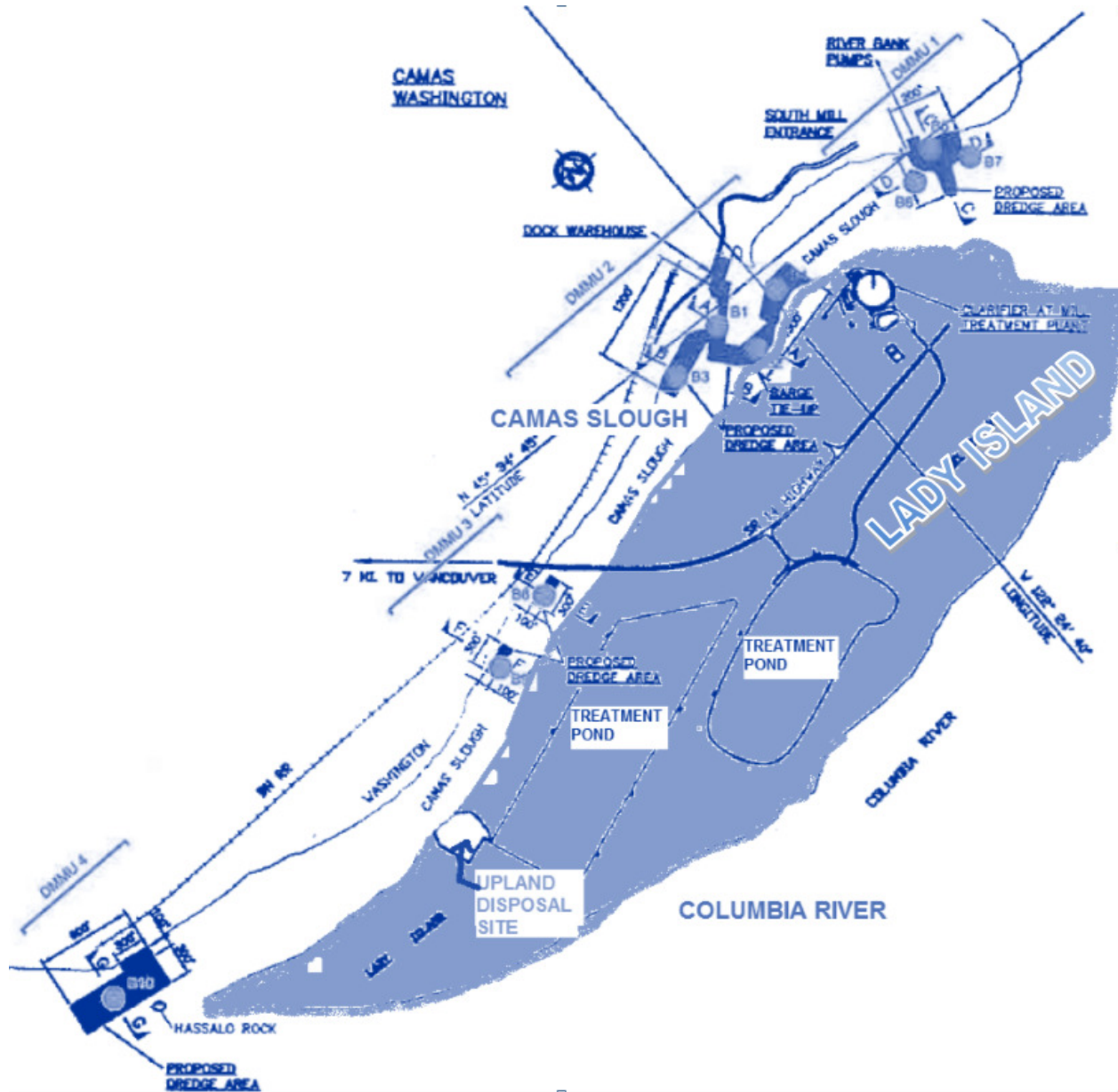
Application Materials: The application was technically complete on October 3, 2017, and included the following documents, which are available for review at the Community Development Department (616 NE 4th Avenue): Narrative; Site drawings; Biological Evaluation (September 11, 2017); Dredge Materials Landfill Operations and Closure Plan (January 2015); Joint Aquatic Resources Permit Application (JARPA) and State Environmental Policy Act Checklist (SEPA).

Comment Deadline: Written comments must be received in the next 30 days, by **November 6, 2017**, before 5:00 p.m. Mailed comments may be directed to the Community Development Department, c/o Shoreline Administrator, 616 NE Fourth Avenue, Camas, WA 98607, or email your comments to communitydevelopment@cityofcamas.us. Only those persons who respond in writing (**indicating interest in the project**) will be included in future mailings, and receive a copy of the final decision.

Public Meeting: The application will be considered for approval by the Shoreline Management Review Committee at a public meeting. Further information regarding the public meeting will be posted on the city's website, and mailed to those interested parties, who have responded in writing to this notice.
