# General Information Safety Tips

- If you are seeking shelter or a safe place to sleep, call the housing hotline at 360-695-9677.
- Keep a phone with you, even phones without service can make a 911 call.
- When it's really cold or really hot outside, go to a shelter.
- Essentials for cold weather: clean/dry socks and something to cover your hands and head.
- Essentials for hot weather: sunscreen, water for hydration.
- Drink water to prevent dehydration & hypothermia.
- Clean up your garbage and keep the area sanitary to prevent disease and infestation.
- Keep your property with you to prevent theft and properly dispose of what you do not need.
- Avoid conflict with others.
- Seek out and utilize available resources to better your personal situation.
