

Notice of Application and Public Hearing Amendment to Zoning (File No. ZC21-02)

Camas School District requested consideration of amending the zoning at two properties located at 5220 NW Parker Street and 2815 NW Leadbetter Drive (Tax Parcels: 84836-000 and 84815-000) with submittal of an application on May 12, 2021. The combined properties are approximately 87.6 acres and are currently zoned Light Industrial/Business Park (LI/BP), wherein the current educational uses are nonconforming (prohibited). The request is to change the zoning from LI/BP to Business Park (BP) in order for the current and future school uses to be considered conforming (permitted) uses. The applicant is not proposing any development of the properties at this time. The application was deemed technically complete on June 15, 2021. The criteria for approval for zoning map amendments can be found at Camas Municipal Code (CMC) Section 18.51.025(B) and 18.51.030.

<u>Public Hearing</u> A public hearing before the city's Hearings Examiner will be held at **4:00 p.m. on August 12**. The public hearing will follow the quasi-judicial process described within Camas Municipal Code §18.55.180.
