January-May Provide early blooming plants.

Mid to Early March Put out Mason Bee houses and nesting cavities (not

the cocoons). 'Local' population of Mason Bees may

be looking for a home!

Late March to Mid-April Place your Mason Bee cocoons into the houses. You

may stagger the emergence by placing ½-1/3 of the

cocoons over 1-3 weeks.

Check the weather for 50-55° for 5 days and blooming flowers. All cocoons should be out by mid-April. Do not fill the emergence container more than ½ full. Check fridge for emerging bees if staggering!

Early June Cover house opening with mesh material or gently

place tubes into mesh bag. Ensure that the nesting cavities will not be exposed to excessive heat or direct sunlight. You are providing summertime protection from a parasitic wasp that emerges in the summer in addition to protecting from earwigs, ants,

and birds.

October to November Harvest Cocoons.

November to March Store cocoons in fridge (34-38°) or protected outdoor

area with ventilation. Place cocoons in ventilated container with a damp paper towel or piece of sponge for humidity. Check on cocoons every month to add

moisture.
